

# CEPHLEX

( Cephalexin Monohydrate )

## Action:

CEPHLEX is a semi-synthetic broad spectrum cephalosporin antibiotic for oral administration. CEPHLEX is acid stable and may be given without regard to meals.

## Indications:

CEPHLEX is indicated in the treatment of :

- Respiratory tract infections . Bacterial sinusitis. Otitis media. Skin and soft tissue infections. Bone and joint infections caused by Staphylococci & P. mirabilis.
- Genito - urinary tract infection including acute prostatitis caused by E. coli, P. mirabilis & Klebsiella species.
- Dental infections caused by Staphylococci & or Streptococci.

## Dosage & Administration:

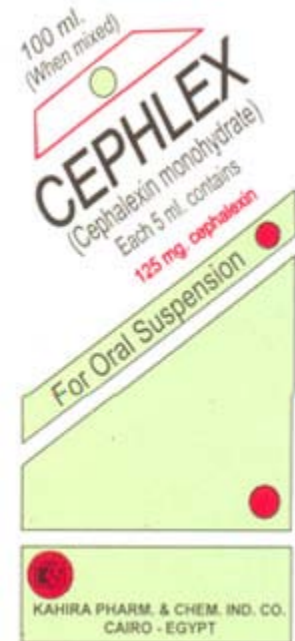
Adults :1 capsules (250mg) every 6 hours.

Children: The usual recommended daily dosage is 25 - 50 mg / kg in equally divided doses.

CEPHLEX suspension 125

Child's Weight dose / day

- 10 kg 1/2 - 1 teaspoonful every 6 hours.
- 20 kg I - 2 teaspoonfuls every 6 hours.



- 40 kg 2 - 4 teaspoonfuls every 6 hours.

**CEPHLEX suspension 250**

- 10 kg :  $\frac{1}{2}$  - teaspoonful every 6 hours.
- 20 kg :  $\frac{1}{2}$  - 1 - teaspoonfuls every 6 hours.
- 40 kg : 1 -- 2 teaspoonfuls every 6 hours.

**Presentation:**

- CEPHLEX 250 mg capsule: Each capsule contains 250mg Cephalexin.
- CEPHLEX granules for oral suspension 125 mg/5 ml.
- CEPHLEX granules for oral suspension 250 rug / 5 ml.

**Packing:**

- Plastic container contains 39.5 gm granules (constituted to 60 ml. with water).
- Boxes of 12 capsules ( 1 strip x 12capsules).

**Storage:**

Store at room temperature , protected from light & humidity.
