

DOLOMINE *sterile eye drops*

Ketorolac Tromethamine

Composition:

Each 5 ml contains:

- Ketorolac Tromethamine sterile (in isotonic ophthalmic solution) 25 mg.

Properties:

Ketorolac is a NSAID . Ketorolac is a non- opioid analgesic & is the only topical NSAID indicating for the temporarily relief of ocular itching due to seasonal allergic conjunctivitis. Dolomine inhibits cyclo-oxygenase enzyme preventing prostaglandin formation, thus prevents the inflammation and produces rapid analgesic activity.

Indications & Usage:

Dolomine is indicated to patients suffering from:

- The temporarily relief of ocular itching due to seasonal allergic conjunctivitis.
- Postoperative inflammation due to cataract extraction.

Contra-Indications:

Dolomine is contraindicated in patients sensitive to any ingredients in the formula. Since patients sensitive to NSAID's are sensitive to Ketorolac Tromethamine.

Side Effects:

- Transient stinging & burning sensation on instillation are most frequent.
- Ocular irritation, allergic reactions, superficial infections,



superficial keratitis are very few reported, eye dryness, corneal infiltrates, corneal ulcer, & visual disturbance are rare.

Dosage & Administration:

The recommended for treatment of:

- Seasonal allergic conjunctivitis: one drop four times daily.
- Postoperative inflammation in patients who have undergone cataract extraction: one drop four times daily should apply to the affected eye, beginning 24 hours after cataract surgery and for the first 2 weeks of postoperative period.

Packing:

A self dropper plastic bottle x 5 ml sterile eye drops.
