

PROXIMOL *Tablets & Drops*

Antispasmodic & for extrusion of ureteric calculi

Composition:

- Tablets : each contains 0.4 mg Halphabarol.
- Drops: each 1 ml (15 drops) contains 0.6 mg Halphabarol.

Properties:

Halphabarol, the active principle of PROXIMOL is the most potent out of four antispasmodics present in the national desert weed "Cymbopogen proximus" or "Halfa Bar". It was discovered, isolated, and thoroughly tested by scientists in Kasr El-Ainy Faculty of Medicine (Cairo University) and The National Research Centre at Dokki, and has been developed and manufactured in Kahira Pharm. & Chem. Ind. Co.

Halphabarol, is a very efficient, direct-acting smooth muscle relaxant which relieves spasm without interfering with or inhibiting the propulsive movement of the muscle which gives it a great value in management of renal colic and in extrusion of ureteric calculi (as dilatation of the ureter occurs below the site of calculus in presence of active propulsion).

Indications:

- Renal colic.
- For extrusion of urinary calculi.

Use in pregnancy:



Safety has not been justified, it is better to be avoided during the first trimester as most of the drugs.

Dosage:

" PROXIMOL is better to be given after meals "

- Tablets: 1-2 tablets three times daily.

- Drops: 10-20 drops three times daily in a glass of water.

N.B.: Plenty of fluid intake together with PROXIMOL is always advisable to help extrusion of renal calculi.

Packing:

- Tablets: Boxes of 20 tablets.

- Drops: Bottles of 15 ml.
