

SEDALINE *Syrup*

Expectorant with antihistaminic

Composition:

Each 100 ml contains:

- Ammonium Chloride 2.376 gm.
- Diphenhydramine Hydrochloride 0.260 gm.
- Sodium Citrate 1.200 gm.
- Menthol 0.020 gm.

Properties:

SEDALINE is a comprehensive nicely flavoured preparation that efficiently relieves cough as it combines the expectorant action of both Ammonium Chloride and Sodium Citrate together with the decongestant effect of the antistamine Diphenhydramine Hydrochloride . It assists in liquefying and expulsion of viscid bronchial secretion and alleviates congestion of upper and lower respiratory mucosa that frequently accompanies cough.

Indications & Usage:

- **To relieve cough and to decongest respiratory mucosa in such cases as bronchitis, common cold, influenza and other similar conditions.**
- **To alleviate histamine-induced bronchospasm.**

Pregnancy:

The drug should be used only when clearly indicated and to be avoided during the first trimester.

Breast – feeding:

The drug should be avoided in nursing mothers.

Dosage & Administration:

- Adults : 1-2 teaspoonfuls 3-4 times daily.
- Children : (over 1 year of age) 1/2-1 teaspoonful 3 times daily.

Packing:

Bottles of 125 ml.
