

TETRAVITON

Double Ampoules

Composition:

1 - Ampoule A (1ml) (Yellow) contains:

- **Vitamin B 1 (Thiamine HCl) 200 mg.**
- **Vitamin B 2 (Riboflavine Sod. Phosphate) 3 mg.**
- **Vitamin B 6 (Pyridoxine HCl) 100 mg.**

2 - Ampoule B (1ml) (Pink) contains:

- **Vitamin B 12 (Cyanocobalamine) 1000 mcg.**

Properties:

Tetraviton is a combination of vitamin B 1 , B 2 , B 6 and B 12 in a highly potent and stable preparation.

Indications & Usage:

Pernicious anaemia, peripheral neuritis especially diabetic and alcoholic polyneuritis, trigeminal neuritis, vomiting of pregnancy, vitamin B complex deficiency, anorexia, agranulocytosis, radiation sickness, coeliac and idiopathic, steatorrhoea which are usually accompanied by malabsorption of vitamin B 12 and during administration of broad-spectrum antibiotics.

Dosage & Administration:

Mix one ampoule A and one ampoule B and inject the mixed solution intramuscularly once daily or every 2 to 3 days according to the case or as prescribed by the physician.

Packing:

Box of 6 ampoules (3 A + 3 B).
